

Digital Tachograph Training



Course Duration: 1 day

Target Audience: Drivers, Operators, Transport Managers & Administration Staff

This course is aimed at primarily at professional drivers but will also be valuable to operators and transport staff that need to have a full grounding in the use of digital tachographs. The course is designed to give participants a good knowledge of the digital tachograph, how to operate it correctly and comply with legislation through proper record keeping and downloading of information. The course covers both passenger & haulage operations.

The course may be run on the operators' premises or any other suitable facility and can be tailored to the operators' individual requirements.
